The community gardens are in very good shape and it is a pleasure to walk around many beautiful surroundings. The recommendations of the BP Tree Management Report are being implemented with the most urgent priority being the removal of the diseased gums in Admiralty Drive outside Sovereignty and Camellia.

Council has approved the planting of the replacement gum trees on the opposite side of the road to ensure they can grow in more optimal conditions. Council has also recommended the removal of all 12 Plane trees planted in Little Silkstone Park at the rear of Mornington and this work will also be undertaken. These trees will be replaced with five Little Gem Magnolias. All adjacent strata representatives have been consulted and have agreed to the proposed work commencing once the weather is a little cooler.

In addition, our Arborist has inspected all the Plane trees and recommended the side trimming of a few which are encroaching on buildings and this work will be undertaken soon. The trees will be inspected regularly and trimmed only on the Arborist recommendation.
