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Country Club Access Security FOBs

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2. Purpose

To ensure the security FOBs issued to a residential building coming online in DP270347 are compatible with the Breakfast Point Country Club. Ensuring the purchasing property owner can minimize the number of FOBs needed for easy and secure access into their residential building and the Country Club.

3. Security FOBs

A Security FOB (FOB) is a small hardware device with built-in authentication used to control access. Breakfast Point FOBs are imbedded with a site code and unique number. The site code for DP270347 must remain confidential to ensure system integrity. The FOB has no other information other than these two numbers. When a new FOB is scanned at BPCC OR the owners residential building, the individual system links the FOB number with the blank access card and allows the operator to load residents' information. No information is stored on the FOB.

4. ACCEPTNET CLIENT for Concept Panels

ACCEPTNET is a security access software system for security FOBs. Breakfast Point Country Club's system is preloaded with access cards that allow the user, BPCC, to load member information onto these cards. The access cards are individually numbered and only a finite number of access cards can be loaded onto the data base. For BPCC the maximum number of cards is 28,100. The memory of the system does not allow any more cards to be stored.

5. Allocation of Security FOB number series

The Community Association Secretary and Country Club Manager are the custodians of the numeric series for allocation to new buildings. Estate Managers or other nominated company/s are to order the required number of FOBs by email to: manager@breakfastpointcountryclub.com.au four weeks prior to delivery. The company will be issued a Tax Invoice and delivery of FOBs on receipt of payment.

6. Activating Security FOBs

It is the responsibility of the builder/site manager to activate and distribute the security FOBs to building owners/tenants. Once distribution of FOBs has commenced, the BPCC Club Manager is to be notified to ensure new residents can be quickly signed up to Breakfast Point Country Club.
